Advanced Training: Secretary of State Denials

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This seminar assists providers in responding to denials of petitions for driving relief (issuance of restricted driving permits and reinstatement of driving privileges). Moderated by Secretary of State Hearing Administrators, the instructors will help professionals determine what interventions are necessary next steps for petitioners to support their burden of proof at their next hearing. Counselors will learn the difference between formal and informal hearings, the most frequent reasons clients are denied driving relief and what role they can play in resolving those issues.

PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

However, in order to perform DUI Evaluations or Risk Education, staff must be certified by IAODAPCA or licensed as a professional counselor, physician, psychologist or social worker, and work for an agency licensed by SUPR.
