3. Student must be in good academic and conduct standing.
4. Requires a letter of nomination from a UIS faculty or staff member.

- The award recipient(s) must agree to have their name and photograph publicized.

Selection Criteria:

- The selection committee will be using the following criteria to make their selection:

Leadership	Demonstrates leadership through formal or informal role on campus by motivating, persuading, and developing common purpose among others that promotes change while also engaging in skill development to improve oneself and their peers.
Perseverance	Demonstrated perseverance by making impactful contribution to department, campus program/initiative, support to peers, etc. despite challenges presented throughout this academic year.
Campus Spirit	Demonstrates a true commitment to being a Prairie Star and showcases campus spirit in all that they do.
