## **Transfer Pathway**

Students may be considered for admission to UIS as a transfer student if they have attempted at least 24 transferable semester hours and have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale from a regionally accredited institution. Remedial and developmental courses are not accepted.

Those who have earned an Associate of Arts, an Associate of Arts and Science, or an Associate of Arts in Teaching degree from a regionally accredited Illinois community college will be admitted to UIS as a junior with general education requirements met. Students having earned an Associate of Science degree may need to take one Humanities/Fine Arts course and one Social/Behavioral Sciences course at UIS in order to complete their general education requirements. Students who have earned an Associate of Science degree degree and believe they have met the requirements may request an academic review by submitting a Student Petition form.

UIS is a participant in the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI), a statewide agreement designed to allow you to complete the Illinois Articulation Initiative General Education Core Curriculum (IAI GECC), as well as credit earned in select majors, between participating institutions. To determine IAI GECC at your community college, use the course planning worksheet available at <u>iTransfer</u>.org. This information is also available from your community college catalog or by speaking with your community college advisor.
