Using your military education benefits at UIS

- A Request for Military Education Benefits form must be submitted PRIOR to the start of the semester.
- A copy of all Certificates of Eligibility and/or approval letters are required.
- To protect confidential information reported on this form, upload all documents to Self-Service. Do not email documents that contain confidential information.
- Students are responsible for paying all tuition and fees that are not covered by their education benefits.
- Students are responsible for checking their <u>UI-Pay</u> student account regularly. If benefit(s) have not been applied, students must contact UIS Financial Aid before the end of the semester.
- Students are required to report all changes made to their program or enrollment to UIS Financial Aid within 3 business days.

Reminders for students using VA education benefits

- Students can download your VA education letter also known as a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) from the VA education and training website.
- If using GI Bill® benefits, students must <u>verify your school enrollment</u> monthly with the VA. For more info call 1-888-442-
- Students should check their GI Bill payments to ensure enrollment is correctly reported to the VA.
- Students can request changes to their VA education benefits through the VA.
- To be eligible for continued use of VA benefits students must meet all of the requirements in the <u>UIS Satisfactory Academic Progress</u> (SAP) policy. Students are responsible for checking their SAP status in Self-service before the start of each semester.

Reminders for students using IVG, ING or MIA/POW waivers

- Students are responsible for tracking their own military education benefit(s) via the <u>ISAC Student Portal</u> or by calling ISAC Student Services at 1-800-899-4722.
- UIS bills ISAC according to eligibility information furnished by the student. If ISAC rejects a claim (usually after the semester is over), the student is responsible for the portion of tuition adfees not paid by the commission.
- The Illinois Veterans Grant (IVG) covers tuition and mandatory fees. Students are responsible for paying all remaining fees.
- The Illinois National Guard (ING) Grant covers tuition and certain allowable fees. Students are responsible for paying all remaining fees.
- The Deceased, Disabled, and MIA/POW (MIA/POW) Scholarship only covers tuition and mandatory fees. Please note that fees for online classes are specifically excluded. Students are responsible for paying all remaining fees.
- IVG or ING will be adjusted when used with the Post-9/11 GI Bill according to the guidelinesestablished by ISAC.
- To be eligible for continued use of IVG, ING or MIA/POW students must meet the earned cumulative GPA component of the <u>UIS</u>
 Satisfactory
